Monroe Scholarship Fund Application FAQs

How many Scholarships are awarded each year?

This varies from year-to-year, depending on donor activity. Usually between 8-12 Monroe Scholarship Fund scholarships are awarded.

How much are scholarship awards?

Scholarships are usually between \$1,000-2,000. Occasionally lower or higher amounts are awarded, depending on the donor's wishes.

How are scholarship recipients selected?

Recipients are matched to various awards depending on chosen area of study along with a weighted consideration of academics, extracurricular activities, financial need and demonstrated leadership. Some awards are based on athletic interests or personal narrative.

If I am applying for the Edith Wheeler Memorial Scholarship, should I also fill out a Monroe Scholarship Fund Application?

YES! If you are eligible to apply for both scholarships, please do so. You cannot be considered for a scholarship unless you have applied for it. Only students enrolled at Masuk High School are eligible for the Edith Wheeler Memorial Scholarship.

Do I need to provide both of my parents' tax forms.

Yes. If your parents do not file a joint tax return, then you need to provide both tax forms. Provide ONLY the 1040 tax form. There is no need to provide worksheets or supporting documents. If you are unable to provide forms from a non-custodial parent, please explain in section II. G. Special Family Circumstances
